Study in New Zealand – Key Information



Scholarships

New Zealand institutions offer various financial aids to support international talent:

- Merit-based scholarships available for high-achieving students.
- Government-funded awards (e.g., Manaaki New Zealand Scholarships).
- University-specific entrance scholarships for international applicants.



Intakes & Timeline

Universities typically follow a two-semester system with flexible options:

- **February (Semester 1):** Main intake with maximum course availability.
- **July (Semester 2):** Second major intake for many programs.
- **November (Summer School):** Limited intake for specific fast-track options.



University Requirements

Standard admission criteria for most degree programs include:

- Academic transcripts from previous education.
- Valid Passport & Statement of Purpose (SOP).
- English Proficiency: **IELTS** (usually 6.0-6.5) or **PTE** equivalents.



Estimated Budget

Financial planning for one academic year (approximate figures):

NZD 25,000 – 40,000

Germany vs New Zealand – Study Comparison

Germany vs New Zealand – Student Visa Process

Step-by-step comparison of visa requirements and procedures

 Finance Proof	Blocked Account €11,904 required	Proof of Funds NZD 20,000 / Year
 Application Method	German Embassy / VFS Global	Online via Immigration NZ
 Visa Interview	 Usually Mandatory	 No Interview
 Medical Test	<i>Not Required</i>	Medical Exam / Chest X-ray
 Visa Fee	€75	375 NZD
 Processing Time	~9 Weeks	~4 Weeks
 Financial Deposit	Must open Blocked Account	Show Bank Balance
